New York, Nov. 8.—Preparations for the trial of the four gangsters indicted with former police lieutenant Becker for the murder of Herman Rosenthal were considerably advanced today when the drawing of a jury was commenced from a special panel of 200 talesmen. The four accused gang leaders are to be given separate trials. "Whitely Louis" will
