RAND OUT FOR MARSHALL

**BAKER OFFICIAL ANNOUNCES HIS
VANDIDACY.**

Friends of Old-Time Sheriff Are Sure
of Success.

Out of the break-neck rough and
tumult race for places of prominence
in the contest for political plums re-
sultant from the change in political
administration at Washington, has

come a new candidate, that of Sher-
iff Rand of Baker, for United States
marshal. This is one of the positions
that make the La Grande postoffice de-
pend upon conciliation between Sen-
ator Bourne, Republican State Chair-
man Williams and President Taft.

Sheriff Rand, the capable sheriff of
Baker county, recently re-elected to
his third term of office, yesterday pub-
licly announced his candidacy for the
office of United States marshal for
Oregon to succeed Marshal Scott, son
of the late Harvey Scott and the pre-
sent incumbent of the office. The pre-
sent status of federal office holders in
ments were regularly made, owing to
the resignation of Senator Bourne in
the senate, the upper house never con-
firmed the appointments with the ex-
ception of the postmaster of Port-

land and one or two other positions.
If the present appointments should
be confirmed, the offices would not be
vacant at this time.

That the popular Baker sheriff
would make a most capable official is
the opinion of his host of friends not
only in Baker county, but throughout
the entire state. Comment on his can-
didacy from various parts of the state
are most favorable and it is believed
that his chance for the appointment
will be good when the state commit-
tee meets for recommendation. In
all probability Senator Lane, the new-
ly elected senator from the state,
will turn the recommendation over to
Senator Chamberlain, and confirma-
tion of the appointee by the senate
would be then only a matter of form.

KEEPS STEP WITH PROGRESS.

Buckley, Wn., Joins the Bitulithic

Such was the case at Buckley, Wn.,
where the recent award met with the
hearty and practically unanimous ap-
proval of those most interested.
