BARRETT NOW IN OREGON

CHIEF OF NATIONAL FARMERS' UNION ARRIVES.

Will Be Present at the Baker Meeting Tomorrow.

Baker, Dec. 2.—(Special)—C. S. Barrett of Union City, Ga., president of the National Farmers' Educational and Co-operative union, who will be one of the principal speakers at the state convention of the union which will be held in this city Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, December 3, 4 and 5, arrived in Baker yesterday. Mr. Barrett who is the head of this great organization of over three million members, has been mentioned as the possible choice of Woodrow Wilson as secretary of agriculture in his cabinet, but Mr. Barrett says that a cabinet portfolio is not on his mind at all. He is here, he says, not for any political reasons whatsoever, but merely to attend the convention of the Oregon state branch of the organization of which he is the head.

Other prominent men of the union who will be here and will have places on the programs of the three days

sessions are J. D. Brown of Arlington, Ore., vice president of the national organization; L. E. Crow, president of the Washington state union; P. W. Cox, of Colfax, Wash., member of the national executive board and many others.

The convention will begin Tuesday morning at 10 o'clock at the Elks' auditorium, where the meetings of the session will be held. Mayor Palmer, representing the city, and President A. F. Harmon of the Baker Commercial club, as the sponsors for the club, will extend the official welcome to the visitors several hundred of whom are expected. The Commercial club has planned an entertainment for the delegates, which will probably be given Wednesday evening, but the details have not yet been given out, although the entertainment committee has been at work several days perfecting their plans.

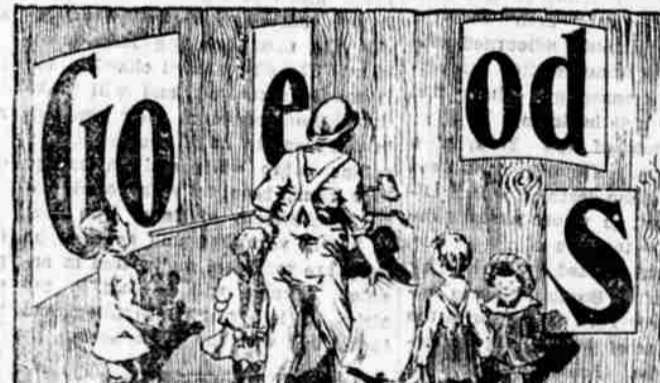
