Name Your Farm

The Observer is desirous of seeing every farm and acreage in Union county given a name and to reach that end we will publish from day to day the names as fast as they are received at this office. Select some appropriate name for your place and forward to "The Farmer's Editor" in care of The Evening Observer, La Grande, Ore.

J. W. Dean of Cove is the first to present his name for the tabulated list of fitting farm names. Warm Spring Fruit Farm, Cove, Ore., is the official cognomen attached, and that name heads the list. Warm Spring Fruit farm is composed of 80 acres of land mostly all in fruit, the principal type of which is prunes, but some of nearly all kinds of fruits are grown. The owner now has over 1000 cherry trees, principally Bings and Lamberts. Cold and warm springs are numerous on the ranch and the title given above is adapted from that fact.

Fairview Farm Next.

Second in the list is Fairview farm owned by C. D. Huffman, on R. F. D. No. 2, one mile east of the city. The place raises alfalfa hay, fruit, poultry, bald barley and wheat and is one of the finest places in the county. The name Fairview has for some time been adopted, Mr. Huffman being a pioneer in that phase of farming. He saw the need of such a proposition early and is a warm supporter of the Observer's efforts to get every farm home under a name by which it will be generally known.

The Suburban Farm.

Miss Sadie McCoy, a former La Grande girl, who is living in Spokane, for the present a guest in the city with friends, adds a unique name to the list of farms having a tangible name. Miss McCoy owns a splendid farm adjoining Island City, level, fertile and productive of big crops always. "The Suburban" is the cognomen she has affixed to her property, and it is fitting in every respect. Miss McCoy doesn't till the soil herself but has a first class notion of what up-to-date farming means and, like so many others, thinks a fitting farm name is one of the first requisites to an up-to-date ranch.
