SPUD MARKET MUCH UPSET

CALIFORNIA OFFERINGS STILL FLOOD MARKET.

Eastern Oregon and Idaho Crops Not Forthcoming Yet.

* PORTLAND PRODUCE TRADE *
* Hop trade active. *
* Eggs are lower. *
* All advance butter. *
* Bean market firmer. *
* Hens in demand. *

A Portland market review has this to say:

Efforts of growers to unload their potatoes at this time are meeting with failure. There is such a limited demand at the moment that it takes only a very small amount of stock to feed the trade.

Prices are seemingly no object with growers anxious to unload. They are overrunning the street with inquiries and every mail brings dozens of requests from producers as to whether dealers want to buy.

Situation in the potato trade is worse at this time than at any time since the local trade can remember. In former seasons when the price was low, growers were able to sell at a price because shippers could find some demand. Now, however, no encouragement can be given.

California growers continue to offer potatoes at a lower price than the stock can be produced for and with a freight handicap against the Pacific northwest grower, he is unable to find a market.

While it is quite probable that some outside business will be offered here after the turn of the year, the outlook is far from being a pleasing one. When the winter breaks it will bring forth immense offerings of supplies by Eastern Oregon and Idaho, where the crops this season broke all previous records.

This is the first time in many years that there has been practically no speculation among potato dealers. The outlook has been so poor all along that line that even the most speculative have been unable to gather the nerve to take hold.
