vator in charge of a young woman conductor and have all of her errands run by a "bell girl" instead of the customary bell boy.

Quite the opposite will be the conditions prevailing on the twenty-second floor of the big hotel. This floor will be reserved exclusively for bachelor guests. No chamber maids or other women servants will be permitted to stop at this floor. All the work will be done by chambermen and valets.

The hotel will maintain a United service club, to which officers of the army and navy and members of the diplomatic corps can obtain membership cards and enjoy club life and entertain their guests. Another feature out of the ordinary will be a section of guest rooms reserved exclusively for the use of newspaper men visiting New York. Here will be found typewriters, an abundance of "copy" paper, a reference library and other conveniences for the free use of the visitors.

Grill rooms, palm gardens, plunge baths, roof gardens and other luxuries that are now so numerous among New York hotels that they have almost become common, will, of course, be found at the new hotel. Everything is being placed in readiness at the McAlpin for the New Year's eve festivities. It is said that every table for the evening was reserved weeks ago. With the main restaurant, the several cafes and a score of private dining rooms the hotel will furnish New Year's cheer for several thousand persons. Nathan Franko, one of the most noted conductors in New York, has signed a two-year contract with the new hotel to conduct its orchestra and to have charge of its musical features. There will be forty pieces in the musical force at the McAlpin, divided among the grill room, restaurant and the tea room. The famous Seventh Regiment band and the Royal Neapolitan players have been engaged as special features for the opening night.
