Ordinance No. 680, Series 1912.

An ordinance levying a tax for general, special, library, special interest fund, park fund and sinking fund purposes for the year 1913. The city of La Grande does ordain as follows: Section 1. That a general tax of 6 mills on the dollar on all assessable property within the city of La Grande, Oregon, be and the same is hereby levied for the year 1913, for general municipal purposes. Section 2. That a special tax of 3 mills on the dollar on all the assessable property within the city of La Grande, Oregon, be and the same is hereby levied for a sinking fund for the payment of the Beaver Creek pipe line bonds as required by ordinance Number 433, series 1909. Section 3. That a special tax of 5 1-2 mills on the dollar on all the assessable property within the city of La Grande, Oregon, be and the same is hereby levied for the payment of special interest on the bonded debt of the city of La Grande. Section 4. That a special tax of one-half (1-2) mill on the dollar on all assessable property within the city of La Grande, Oregon, be and the same is hereby levied for park purposes. Section 5. That a special tax of one mill on the dollar on all assessable property within the city of La Grande, Oregon, be and the same is hereby levied for free library purposes. Section 6. That a special tax of one-half (1-2) mill on the dollar of all assessable property within the city of La Grande, Oregon, be and the same is hereby levied for the payment of court expenses and interest, caused by the contesting of the payment of street assessments and where such expense has heretofore been paid out of the general fund and that the proceeds of this special tax be turned into said general fund. Section 7. That the recorder of the city of La Grande, Oregon, is hereby authorized and required to give notice of the foregoing levy to the county clerk of Union county, Oregon, on or before the 15th day of December, 1913.
