This means of conveying to the mind real pictures of the subjects taught, is one of the more recent innovations in the art of teaching. No less authority than Edison himself predicts that the art of teaching by means of moving pictures is going to revolutionize the methods of imparting knowledge. With the proper explanation of the different phases of iron and steel making the scholars should get an up to the minute idea of this all important topic.

Prof. Stout also informs the Observer that there will be no exercises in the different schools this year, but that all the programs will be left to the different churches.
