TURKEYS ON SLIGHT CLIMB

POORER GRADES ADVANCE ONE CENT.

Grocers Offer Big Stock of Supply Today Without Price Changes.

On the eve of Christmas, turkeys and other holiday fowl are holding a firm price, with a slight incline upwards in the poorer grades of turkeys. Top turkey prices remain at 28 cents but the poorer qualities have gone up one cent. At these figures the trading is very brisk and the Idaho birds offered for sale are usually of a high grade. Ducks and geese remain unchanged with buying brisk in that line of goods.

While the meat dealers are tendering choice lines of meat the grocerymen are not behind and today and tomorrow morning are the hours that the grocers will be called upon most strenuously. They opened this morning with great stacks of choice edibles, and no change in prices, but ere noon inroads had been made on the piles. Early shopping is noticeable everywhere this year and by tomorrow afternoon and evening it is doubtful if the store keepers will have much of the Christmas goodies line left in stock. Housewives are compassionate relative to the horses and men that must deliver the orders, hence the early rush.
