FOUR LA GRANDERS IN GLEE CLUB

Oregon's University Glee Club will usher in the new year to La Grande theatregoers and music lovers. The "warblers" are billed to appear at Steward's opera house, New Year's night. The fact that there are four local boys in the club—Henry Heldbreich, Ray Williams, George Broadbridge and Harold Grady—will add a great deal of interest to local people in the concert.

Under the apt direction of Professor M. L. Bowman, for many years leading bass soloist for the Royal Victoria Opera company, the club has reached a perfection that would do credit to any professional organization. Among some of the numbers rendered by the club are: "The Sword of Ferrara," "The Plainsman's Song," a group of three negro songs, and "Brown's Lullaby."

The program is mingled with stunts and sketches—that are bound to please. A quartet composed of Delbert Stannard of Portland, Bert Jerrard of Pendleton, Earl Fortmiller of

Albany and Harold Grady of La Grande, bring down the house with their songs and jokes. In this stunt, Grady takes the role of Professor Organus, world's renowned ventriloquist, while the remainder of the quartet take the part of figures.

George Broadbridge of La Grande is featured in a travesty on Hamlet's soliloquy which is a scream from the beginning to the end. With him appears Willard Shaeffer who delights the audience with his Swedish dialect songs.

Vernon Vawter of Medford and Bert Jerrard of Pendleton appear in a sketch, entitled "A Bit of Nonsense" in which they introduce piano duets, songs and dialogues with a touch of professionalism which is really surprising. During the action of the sketch, Bert Jerrard sings the Pendleton Roundup song with great success.

The program closes with a skit entitled "Posted" by the entire club of thirty, in which popular up-to-date songs are introduced.
