Social Scientists Meet.

Boston, MASS., Dec. 27.—Men and women from all parts of the United States who take an active interest in the promotion of various social sciences and reforms gathered in Boston today for the annual meetings of societies organized for the discussion of such subjects. These organizations are the American Association for Labor Legislation, the American Sociological society, the American Economic association, the American Statistical Association, the American Political Science association, and the American Historical association, of which last named organization Colonel Theodore Roosevelt is the president.

The meeting that promises to be of most interest to the general public is the annual session of the American Association for Labor Legislation. The session was opened this morning with an address by J. R. Commons explaining the work of the Wisconsin commission in enforcing the factory inspection laws. This afternoon Oscar S. Straus of New York, former secretary of the department of commerce and labor, spoke on the need of a new federal employees' accident compensation law.

ROADBRIDGE MAKES A HIT

The biggest find in the way of stunt material for the University of Oregon Glee club was the couple composed of Willard Shaver of Portland and Gray Broadbridge of La Grande. Their skit entitled "A Travesty or Two and a Parody of Two" was original with them. M. L. Bowman, director of the glee club did not know of their plans until they were in completed form ready for their tryout before him. Willard Shaver as "Yens Yensen"

recites the experiences of John Alden and the fair Priscilla and of William Tell in a revised manner suited to the Swedish brogue. Shaver has worked during the summer in the fishing grounds of the lower Columbia where he came into contact with many Norwegians and Swedes. It was while at his summer's work that he learned his stunt.

Broadbridge appears in long black raven locks garbed in a Prince Albert coat and recites a modern version of Hamlet's Soliloquy. In the same act he assumes the role of a hard-hearted maid who will not yield to the proposals of marriage by her Swedish lover. The whole skit is ludicrous in the extreme and is one of the four parts of the program calculated to cause a wholesome laugh. Mr. Bowman, the director, believes in variety of attractions. "A full program of good music would be tiresome," he says. "I have endeavored to make the program full of surprises in order to break the possibility of tiring the audience with a straight musical program."
