German Studies Canada.

Edmonton, Alta., Dec. 28.—Dr. Semen Demydchuk, professor of philosophy, representing the Educational society of Lemberg, Galicia, has come

to Edmonton to obtain first-hand information and study agricultural conditions in central Alberta, with the intention of assisting his countrymen in their native land. He says the Ukrainians have become tired of conditions under which they have to live at home, and are beginning to feel that to have opportunity for development they must seek them in other lands. There are 250,000 Galicians in the dominion of Canada and about 5,000 in and near Edmonton. They are doing well. Professor Demydchuk will also visit points in the United States.
