SHIPMENTS ARE LIVELY AFTER SHORT FEED.

Hogs Remain Uniform—Eggs Firm and High.

In spite of the large receipts of sheep in all the markets of the country, sheep are on the incline. Chicago reports receipts of 32,000 yesterday, Omaha and Kansas City have large receipts and the number on the Portland market are in keeping with shipments elsewhere. All quotations are a cent or somewhat less for the last few days in advance of prices a week ago. Short feed in some sections is responsible for the large shipments on the middlewestern states. Hogs have not undergone much of a change. There is a slight indication that the price will be better in a few days. Today's quotation are a few cents higher for the best grades than yesterday's, and the supply is good. Eggs continue to remain at fancy

prices in spite of the fact that the supply in the coast cities is plentiful. Wheat has gone up a cent in the Portland market and foreign reports would indicate that it is destined to be steady from now on. The damage done the fruit growers and truck raisers of California will in time have its effect on the local market. Some shipments of fresh vegetables received the other day were frozen and the supply at the present time is not as plentiful as usual. Prices remain the same for today.
