Greek papers from New York report the presence of some ten thousand Greeks awaiting transportation to Greece. According to the statistics of that paper 150,000 men have left the United States and 50,000 are on the fighting line. Scores of the men who have been in this country have fallen in battle or are in the hospitals, at Athens and Corinth and other cities.

LOGANBERRY MEN MAKE MONEY.

That is Why O. A. C. Will Give Special Course for Four Weeks

Oregon Agricultural College, Corvallis, Ore., Jan. 8.—"The loganberry is creating more interest in the northwest at the present time, perhaps, than any other horticultural activity," said Prof. C. I. Lewis this morning discussing the new courses to be offered in the winter short course which opens Jan. 9 for a four week's term.

"The interest in loganberry culture is due to the fact that for the past two years the loganberry men have been making lots of money," he continued. "They have been making as high as from \$200 to \$250 an acre profit in a number of cases. This berry seems to have unlimited possibilities provided it is handled in the proper way and proper organization is effected." "The new course will deal with the growing of the berry and the handling of the crop by canning, by evaporating and by the manufacture of loganberry juice.
