## TEST ALARM AT 12 O'CLOCK

MORNING AND EVENING TESTS ABANDONED

Commencing January 15 Three Taps to Be Sounded at 12

DAILY ALARM TEST TO BE CHANGED.  
Commencing January 15, a new system of daily tests of the La Grande fire department alarm system will be inaugurated. Chief Benham announces that the morning and evening tests will be abandoned for one daily test, sent over the wires at high noon. It has been the practice, and will be until the 15th, to tap the bell at 7 a. m. and 8 p. m., but commencing on the 15th three taps will be sounded at high noon. The morning and evening tests will be abandoned.

Although widespread publicity has been given to the residents of La Grande in re fire alarm, there still prevails the belief that it is necessary to call the city recorder in turning in alarms. The fire department has a telephone for that purpose and its number is Main 750. To turn in an alarm to any other number is a loss of valuable time. This fact has never been fully understood, it appears.
