Imbler Sends Choice Grades to Eastern Families' Tables

Imler, Jan. 22.—(Special)—A carload of potatoes have been sold by Geo. L. Cleaver and Sherwood Williams for the Chicago market. The potatoes are large, smooth, extra fancy, averaging 72 to the box. They are wrapped in paper the same as apples and are intended for the fancy trade in Chicago. This speaks well for the Imbler district and for Oregon. When the Chicago market goes through the states of Montana and Colorado to Oregon for choice potatoes, the potatoes grown here must certainly be of a choice quality.

While the price of wheat has not materially changed in the last week the general opinion is that now the

price is on a basis of supply and demand altogether and there is no likelihood that any violent change backward should be looked for. Flour has not as yet advanced in La Grande and there is no likelihood that it will unless a violent shift in the price upward takes place. Most of the big purchases on the coast are being made by the millers which would indicate that there is going to be an advance in the near future.

Vegetables Are Scarce.
Radishes from the hot house are on the market. Two bunches for 15 cents is the price. In other lines there is little supply and will be from now on.

Cattle and Hogs Unchanged.
Although the receipts on the Portland markets were heavy, the demand was equal to the supply and the price remained at the figures for last week. Hogs jumped up ten cents and cattle ones.

Honey in combs is to be had at 20c a lb. or 3 lbs. for 50c—the quality is fine and is an Oregon product—coming from Hermiston.
