**BAKER TALKS LEAGUE CLUB**

SOLICITING COMMITTEE IS AFTER BACKING.

Commercial Club and Fans Take up the Matter.

There was plenty of enthusiasm displayed at a well attended meeting of the baseball fans at the Commercial Club parlors last evening, when the preliminary steps were taken towards the organization of a team to represent Baker in the Tri-state league the coming season, says the Baker Democrat of yesterday.

First, last and all the time, there is but one necessary essential to the carrying out of the plan to give this city organized baseball—money. Two thousand dollars is necessary to start the ball rolling, and while the Commercial club will lend moral support and has taken the initiative by sending Secretary O'Gorman to the league director's meeting, still the enterprise must be absolutely financed outside our industrial organization, which is carrying all the load possible at present and has undertaken much else for the coming year.

If the local business men and fans want baseball, they must lend financial support, and if all contribute to the cause no one corporation, firm or individual will be hit hard. A baseball team in the league, which under the proposed plan would consist of Boise, Baker, La Grande, Pendleton, Walla Walla and North Yakima, would be one of the best bits of publicity the city could undertake this year. It will help the town on the map.

One plan is suggested that would give North Yakima, Walla Walla and Boise six consecutive games every alternate week, and Pendleton, La Grande and Baker three games every alternate week. This, it is believed, would almost if not quite make the league self-sustaining. North Yakima has already assured the directors that the city will come in, and the meeting at La Grande last Monday was adjourned to Boise on February 8th for the sole purpose of giving Baker time to organize. The league is organized under the national organization and would give this city the first organized ball in its history.

A committee of three, consisting of Chas. A. Hosler, Dr. H. J. Horton and Attorney W. H. Strayer was named last evening to take charge of the soliciting. The above named their assistants and all will meet today at the Geiser Grand for lunch, when further plans will be outlined. It is earnestly requested that every fan who wants baseball in Baker this year, who can possibly do so, be present also to take part in the meeting, which may mean the success or the failure of league ball for this city in 1913.
