## IMBLER DRIFT CLOGS TRAIN

LOGGER STALLED AND BRANCH LINE IDLE.

Main Line Service Moves About on Schedule—Telocaset Drifts Big

Effective tie-ups have again occurred on the branch line, this time near Imbler and up until late this afternoon, there is no indication that a passenger train will be sent out on the branch line until tomorrow. The logging train was stalled this morning in the drifts near Imbler and the heavy weight nature of the snow makes clearance difficult. Traffic on the main line continues

to move—principally through the diligence of the officials in keeping the rotaries at work. Telocaset drifts are proving bothersome but trains are moving, and not far behind time at that. However, as it snows from four to six inches every day this week, the difficulty may soon become such that only extreme effort will move the trains.

Another five-inch snowfall in La Grande last night has brought the total for the month up to about three feet. There has been no appreciable melting of snow during the past 24 days, either, and street crews continue to have difficulty in keeping sewers open. These are in fact, clogged in most instances and the damage and inconvenience that a shutoff would create becomes daily more serious.

Superintendent Wm. Bollens is here today to personally direct the work of keeping service in motion.
