HOGS LEAP ANOTHER 15C

SIX NINETY NOW PRICE OF PORKERS HERE.

Cattle Hold Their Own—Wool is Higher in Eastern Markets.

Hogs have advanced another 15 cents and are within striking distance of first grade beeves. Best grades are being taken at \$7.50 on the Portland market and at \$6.90 on the La Grande market. The receipts were not heavy at the yards and the dealers are bidding high for the stock to compete with the country killed offerings. Hogs fell off a few cents in the Chicago and the Kansas City market but the Portland market has remained firm.

Cattle Hold Their Own.

Cattle have shown no change in the past week, save that the less choice grades are going up to eight cents. The best beeves have not climbed over these figures but the difference is not so great. It is reported that Montana will ship to the coast instead of Kansas City and Chicago owing to the better prices. Neither will there be a middleman. All of the ranchers will ship direct from the ranges, thus solving the problem of the middleman.

Grain Bags Are Higher.

Now comes the announcement that grain bags have gone up a cent in some markets owing to the destruc-

tion by fire of one of the largest bag factories of Indiana. They are now quoted at nine and a half cents in the Portland market and indications are for a higher price still.

Wheat Going up.

In all the markets of the world save Argentina the price of wheat is going up. London, Paris and Berlin quote wheat at a half to 5-8 cent higher than at the close of the market yesterday. Argentine is getting rid of all wheat on hand to make room for the crop that will be soon harvested.

Wool is Higher.

The eastern market, especially Boston, have been clamoring for wool and the offerings have been very light. This will have the effect to increase the price on the coast. Following are corrected quotations to date:
