 European Champion Heavyweight to Wrestle.

Ed Warner, Y. M. C. A. instructor is in Pendleton this afternoon along with other fans to witness the biggest thing in the wrestling line that Eastern Oregon has seen in some few years. At any rate one of the principals is a world-famous character and Ben Jackson the Pole's opponent, is a well-known Northwestern heavyweight. Jackson arrived in Pendleton Saturday evening and appears to be in excellent shape for his match.

He worked out with Ernest Pinaud the Carlisle welterweight wrestler, in the P. A. A. C. gymnasium yesterday afternoon. Several local men saw the big fellow in action, among them being J. V. Tallman, Clark Nelson, F. E. Welch, W. N. Matlock and Frank Mohler.

That the match is attracting considerable attention from the outside is evidenced by the fact that several fans among traveling men are staying over for it. W. C. Bowersmith of Chicago, a friend of Sam Wurbarger and Charles Olsen; Henry J. Ruld of New York, who for two years was manager of George Bothner, and F. E. Silversmith, a member of the

Denver Athletic club, are here for the match.

That Ben Jackson, the Eastern Washington man who is to wrestle Zbyszko here tonight, has cavalier blood in his veins was evidenced Saturday evening in the train which brought him to Pendleton. Mrs. J. W. Logan of Seattle, en route for the east, was seated near Jackson when a man rather the worse for liquor showed a desire to continue his attentions. The wrestler watched the affair until the drunk became really offensive, then lifted him from the floor and escorted him to the smoking car.
