MOORE GAME RESERVES. Several Thousand Acres of Land in Haines District Set Aside. Agreement for the setting aside of several thousand acres of land as game reserves were filed today with the county clerk of this county, relates the Baker Herald. The stipulations are made between W. L. Finley state game warden, through his deputies Charles B. Orat and J. W. Welch, E. Pratt, W. M. Hearing and Armand W. Perkins and W. H., J. H., and W. R. Hutchinson.

It provides for the protection of game on these places for a period of five years also the feeding of the game in winter in case feeding is necessary.

Y. M. C. A. News of Current Interest Noted Hereunder, Direction of J. H. Rudd, General Secretary.

At the 14th international conference of the Railroad Young Men's Christian Association great interest was shown. If the more than 1600 delegates present at this conference in Chicago in 1912, there were eight railroad presidents, 13 vice presidents, five general managers, besides many other officials. This branch of the Y. M. C. A. is doing a great work and both employers and employees are showing their appreciation. One of the very interesting addresses of the session was given by W. G. Lee, president of the Brotherhood of Railway Trainmen. His address as it appears in the Railroad Association Magazine follows:

"Mr. Munn, delegates and visitors to the 14th international conference of the Young Men's Christian Association: In accepting the honor that has been conferred upon me, it is with the understanding that the credit and honor go to the association that I happen to represent. Some time ago your good secretary, Brother Moore, wrote to me and asked if I would be kind enough to attend at least one day's session. I consented and came here this morning for the purpose of meeting with you for a few moments.

Why should not the chief executive of all of these railway organizations be in favor of the Y. M. C. A., particularly the Railroad Young Men's Christian Association, because they better than many people, know the good work that has been done, the assistance that has been rendered, and the wholesome meals prepared, the sanitary conditions that are furnished to our men when they could not be able to secure them otherwise?

I know something of what the Railroad Y. M. C. A. has done for the men I represent over this country, and I wish it were possible to say to you that every trainman in the United States and Canada held membership in the Y. M. C. A. (Applause.) I wish it were possible to say to you, as I have heard said in the past, that all good men hold membership in a certain organization, but unfortunately all members of that organization are not good men. In holding membership in the Y. M. C. A., and you secretaries and men handling the Y. M. C. A.'s in the different parts of the country may in some instances form a rather bad opinion of some of the members of these organizations—or some of your membership, I will say—men bow the knee in these four great brotherhoods and in some of the others, and swear to be upright, better men and better citizens, in every way. Some of them fail to do it, unfortunately. In our own organization Benevolence, Sobriety and Industry is the motto on the banner. Sobriety! It is a great virtue to be sober in thought, word and action and the founders of our Brotherhood appreciated the dangers of intemperance when they inscribed that grand motto on our banner. Intemperance murders the soul. It is the son of all villainy, the mother of all crime, and the father of all abomination. And so, why should not the president of the Brotherhood of Railway Trainmen come to you today bringing the best wishes of more than 125,000 members? (Applause.)

Sometimes it is necessary to refer to those gone before us in order to bring those who are left to a proper realization of their duty, and so in calling your attention to the fact that in 1911 the records of the Brotherhood of Trainmen show that we paid for death and disability insurance to 1742 men in 1911, killed or totally disabled. The sum was \$2,197,170. The Brotherhood has paid since its organization to the widow, the orphan and to the maimed the sum of \$25,014,304.31, up to October
