Section 2. It is further provided that said assessment shall become due and payable immediately after the same is entered in the docket of city liens, and delinquent within ten days thereafter.

Section 3. When the recorder of the city of La Grande shall have completed the special assessment roll in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance, he shall without delay, give at least five days' notice in one or more of the newspapers having a general circulation in said city of La Grande the time when such assessments may be paid in installments, provided each property owner will make application therefor within ten days from the date of the first publication of said notice, said application to be made under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 5, Title 26, L. O. L.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the mayor and publishing in one issue of the La Grande Evening Observer.

Passed the common council on the 5th day of February, 1913, by eight councilmen voting therefor.
