

REMILLARD A REAL PIONEER

LATE CITIZEN MARRIED PERIOD OF MANY YEARS.

Eulogy Delivered at Bier Praises the Late Mr. Remillard.

Lucien Remillard, who was buried

on last Wednesday was born in Montreal, Canada, in the year 1850. In another month he would have been 63 years old. In 1865 he married Eva Jones of Cove, Oregon. To them were born three daughters, Mrs. Edwin Thomas, of La Grande; Mrs. Lulu Leonard of Lewiston, Idaho; and Mrs. Elva Stringer of La Grande. There are four grandchildren.

During the obsequies last week, the following, among other things was said as an eulogy:

"He had not passed the milestone in life which marks the lives of son-

but at that he had lived to see many changes in the country that was dear to his heart.

"Within his life's span he had seen history made and helped to make it. He was of the courageous sort who came into the frontier to hew out a future from the rough—a thing that many shrink from doing.

His long residence in La Grande and the Grande Ronde valley earned for him the title of 'friend and neighbor' in the highest sense of those words. His life was full of charity, mostly of which was unspoken and out of the limelight of popularity. He chose the other path—the path that leads to those in trouble without noise or murmur. But it can be said today that a man has departed this life who ever shared his earthly wealth with humanity not so fortunate as himself; that no worthy man ever asked and did not receive from Lou Remillard.

"Some able person has said: 'Life is a narrow vale between the cold and barren peaks of two eternities. We strive in vain to look beyond the heights. We cry aloud, and the only answer is the echo of our wailing cry. From the voiceless lips of the unreplying dead there comes no word; but in the night of death hope sees a star, and listening love can hear the rustle of a wing.'"
