### MORE ELK ON WAY TO OREGON

PLAN NOW IS TO CHANGE THE RANGE.

Would Have Elk Pastured Near Wallowa Lake Hereafter.

Another band of elk will be brought to Wallowa county from Jackson's Hole, Wyoming, in a few days. W. E. Lefel, deputy game warden of Wallowa county, received word the first of the week that the animals were on the way out from the Wyoming pasture ground to Buell Idaho, here they are to be loaded on the railroad.

There will be from 15 to 30 elk in the band. All will come straight through to this county and will be unloaded at Joseph where they will be kept in a corral and fed until the snow goes off. They they will be taken to the Billy Meadow pasture and placed with the elk brought in last spring. Mr. Lefel does not want to undertake to haul them to the Chesnimnus under conditions like those last year when the first band was taken through the mud and snow to the government pasture.

**May Change Elks' Range.**  
 An effort will be made this season, Mr. Lefel says, to have the whole band moved from the Chesnimnus to a pasture at the base of the Wallowa range, near Joseph, relates the Enterprise Record-Chief. This pasture could be established on the shores of the lake, and thus would add another attraction to that beauty spot. Enough of the mountainside could be fenced to give summer pasture, and the game would be near the valley and winter feed.

Hay costs about \$20 a ton delivered at the Billy Meadow pasture, and could be bought at a far less figure in the farming district. The elk would need feed all winter long, however, if brought to the lake district while they have to be fed only part of the cold season in the Chesnimnus, as they are now living on moss on the trees. There is none of this moss on the slopes of the Wallowa mountains.

But the change would place the

elk where they could be seen. They would attract visitors to the county. The Chesnimnus pasture is so remote that very few people ever go there to see the game.
