A Universal Word.
One of the first words that a baby says is mamma or mother, and it is not strange, therefore, to find it one of the first and simplest words in every language. There is no word easier for a child to say than "ma" unless it be "pa." In Hebrew and Arabic mother is "em" and "am." It is "mam" in Welsh and "moder" in Anglo-Saxon. In other languages it is slightly different, but near enough like our own word "mother" to make it an almost universal word, so that a child crying the word in any language could be understood in almost any other language. Here are a few of the names:
Madr in Persian. Moder in Swedish.
Matr in Sanskrit. Moder in Danish.
Meter in Greek. Moeder in Dutch.
Mater in Latin. Mutter in German.
Madre in Italian. Mater in Russian.
Mere in French. Mathair in Celtic.

Some Odd Wills.
