## LA GRANDE Y. M. C. A. DEPARTMENT.



Y. M. C. A. News of Current Interest Noted Hereunder, Direction of J. H. Rudd, General Secretary.

I wish in the following words to let the men of this city know what they have had a large part in doing during the past months. Between seventy-five and one hundred of the business men of this city have during the past nine months been supporting the Y. M. C. A. in La Grande. Some have supported only in a financial way, others have aided both financially and in personal interest. Still others have aided the work wonderfully by service and interest alone. To all of these men goes the credit for work done during the past nine months in our little growing Y. M. C. A. No one department of the association work could be well organized or completely handled though something has been done along many of the usual lines of activity.

### Physical Department.

The first part that the association took in the physical activities of La Grande was to aid in starting off, what proved to be a very interesting series of Twilight League baseball games. The swimming classes for boys at Ora Dell with sometimes fifty boys in at one time was another small part of our activities. The gymnasium work supplied during the winter months has been as successful as might have been expected with a small amount of equipment.

### Religious Work.

The religious work has been conducted largely to the Sunday afternoon meetings for men. During the time that these meetings have been held attendance has been close and regular. The speakers for these meetings have come from as far east as Boise, Idaho, and as far

west as Salem, Oregon. Perhaps one of the main features in this phase of the work is that any man who may have had occasion to call at the Y. M. C. A. has received a Christian welcome.

### Boy's Work.

Besides the swimming classes the boys have had many hikes and valuable training in other ways. The Boy Scouts have learned some splendid things during the winter months. The Indians have learned endurance, obedience and the value of friendship. The boys gymnasium classes have been most popular during the winter. While less than fifty took advantage of the "gym", they have surely enjoyed it. We must not forget to mention our boys camp. Seventeen boys spent a happy week in camp. This year should see at least twice as many boys in camp. It was great. The little personal conferences with individual boys cannot be mentioned here, though important.

### Employment.

No record has been kept of the men and boys who have found positions through the Y. M. C. A. Both employers and those seeking employment have been served.

### Socially.

Socially the Y. M. C. A. has steadily increased in its usefulness. An estimate based on one month's record of attendance at the Y. M. C. A. since headquarters were moved to 19 Depot street, November 1, 1912, would show a total attendance to date of approximately 3500 men and

boys. Through the co-operation of several men and especially the Triangle club the rooms have assumed a very Y. M. C. A. appearance. At present any visitor to the association as he enters finds a welcome, a place to meet his friends, to spend his leisure hours. Games are provided, reading material, music, a place to write, all for any man who may care to use what the citizens of La Grande have so willingly provided.

### In Detail.

A hundred and one problems great and small have had to be solved but a discussion of them would only be tiresome to the readers of this column. Let it be enough they have been met. Finally as the year's work looms in sight we are glad to report that interest has steadily grown to such an extent that the people of our city and surrounding territory are asking that this infant Y. M. C. A. be given a good home. Will La Grande rally to the call?

### Trains Alarm at Pendleton.

"At the East Court street railroad crossing where the little Grubb girl was killed several weeks ago the O. W. R. & N. company has installed a warning bell, the work have been done yesterday. As a result of the improvement travel across the crossing will be safeguarded and it is hoped to prevent any further accidents there.

"We have installed the warning bell on East Court street and we will place bells at other crossings in the city if the city authorities or the people wish to do so," stated T. F. O'Brien, local agent, to the East Oregonian today. According to Mr. O'Brien he will notify the city officials to that effect. In the view of Mr. O'Brien it would be futile to place bells on the crossings near the depot as the switch engine would keep such bells ringing almost continuously. However, he regards it as possible the city may wish a warning bell at West Webb or West Alta crossings. If so the bell will be provided.
