MASSACRE IN MEXICO

Large Number of Federals Slain in Interior Mexico, Says Report.

Juarez, Mex., March 22.—Massacre of 135 federal prisoners by Maderistas is reported in letters brought to this city by a refugee. The letters say the recent Maderista attack at Parral resulted in great damage to the cathedral and destruction of the central market by exploding shells.

Among the victims of the massacre are said to be Guillermo Porras, secretary of state in Chihuahua when Diaz was president, Rodolfo Reyes and Rudolfo Chavez, all of whom were prominent in business circles.
