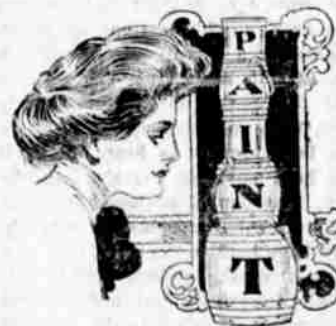

### Sweetbreads.
