Walter Kivette returned to Union last night.

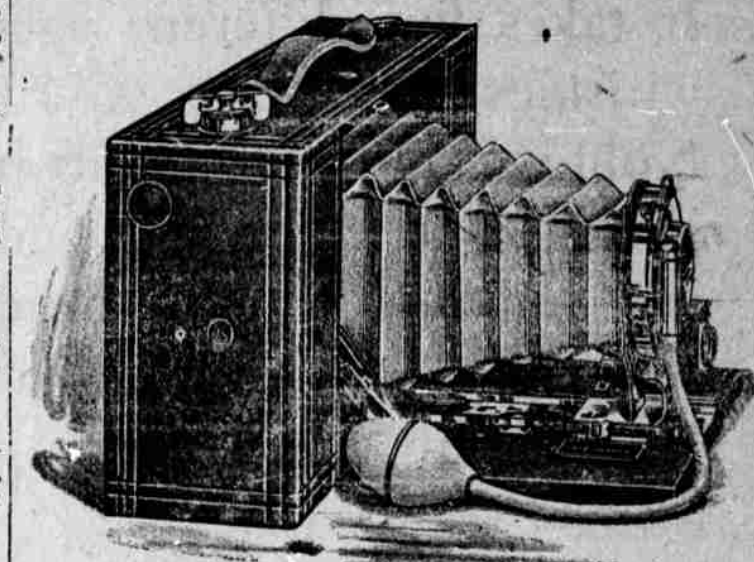
