PAYETTE Y. M. C. A. EXAMPLE OF WHAT SMALL CITIES CAN DO

(Edited by J. H. Rudd.)

The report of the Portland Association for the first three months of the year shows among its many other activities that 41 men coming from the east or foreign countries were looked up, assisted in one way or another and put in touch with friends or relatives who had written about them. At all the leading ports of entry, Y. M. C. A. secretaries are located who meet young men coming from other countries, learn where they are going and notify the secretary of the nearest association. Mr. Rudd of the local organization has recently found two young men in this way.

The public schools of Portland recently engaged Dr. T. E. Spaulding of Newton, Mass., an educational expert, to make an examination of the schools of the city. During his visit he also visited the educational department of the Y. M. C. A. which has 1361 students in its day and evening classes. He comments on their work as follows: "The educational work of the Y. M. C. A. is truly remarkable. I seldom deal in superlatives, but I want to say that this is the greatest thing I have ever seen. The Association treats young men who come to it as individuals, it gives them the kind of instruction they need and it gets remarkable results."

"This is just what our public school's need. At present we are turning all our children together providing for them a hard and fast system that ignores the need of the individual. The Y. M. C. A. finds out all it can about the characteristics and qualifications of the man who comes to learn, and teaches him the subjects most valuable to him."

Two record breaking campaigns for Y. M. C. A. building funds have been recently conducted at Corsicana, Tex., and Grand Island, Neb. Both cities have a population of 10,000 people. Corsicana raised \$88,000 in six days and Grand Island \$71,000 in three days.

Railroad Associations are located at 252 division points throughout North America. Six new buildings were opened last year and 18 more are already assured for 1913 and 1914.

These Associations are actively co-operating in the "Safety First" movement and weekly lectures and demonstrations are given in the Association buildings.

It has often been thought that a Y. M. C. A. could not be successfully conducted in cities of less than five or six thousand population. The little city of Payette, Idaho, with about 3000 people has proven a notable exception. A building costing \$24,000 and provided by popular subscription was opened four years ago. The organization has had a steady growth since the beginning and now has a membership of 325. Its boys department is divided into groups of 10 to 15 boys who engage in gymnasium work, Bible study, tennis, scouting, etc. The building is also used by an average of ten to twelve other organizations each month.

Some of the big league baseball players are in hearty sympathy with the Y. M. C. A. work and have given active co-operation during the winter months. Hans Wagner led one of the contesting sides in a membership campaign in Pittsburg, "Statty" did the same in his native county of Westchester, Pennsylvania, and Clark Griffiths performed a like service at Washington, D. C.

Scouts Attention.

The Boy Scouts will meet next Friday evening at 7:30 in the Christian church instead of at the Y. M. C. A. Scoutmaster Vinacke wishes to have every members present. The Scouts of La Grande have been for the past several months under the direction of the local Y. M. C. A. Their work has attracted the attention of other smaller towns of the valley until now the Y. M. C. A. has several calls to assist in organizing similar groups in these places. By correspondence Cove has recently been assisted in organizing a troop of Scouts. Today the

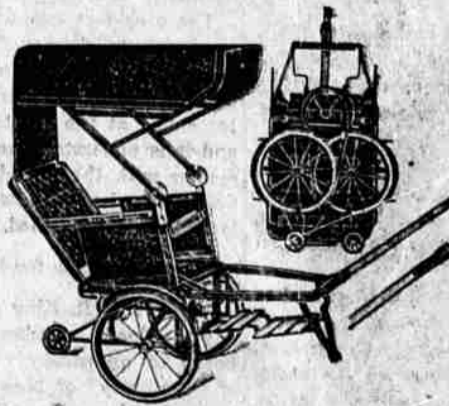

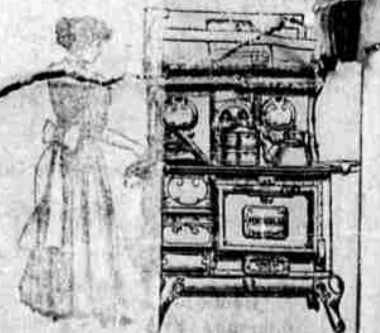
