LA GRANDE 4TH IN BIG MEET

BAKER SQUAD MASTERS OF THE CONTEST.

Conkey Principal Point Winner for La Grande at Pendleton.

Pendleton, Ore., May 5.—(Special)—The Baker high school track team made almost a clean sweep at the annual Eastern Oregon interscholastic track meet at Round-up park Saturday afternoon, winning both the meet and relay race and taking first place in 11 out of 14 events. Baker made 61 points and Wallows, the nearest competitor for first honors, but 18.

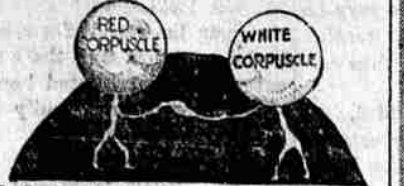
Frye Herbert of Baker was the individual star of the meet, winning three first places for a total of 15 points. Harold Weeks of Baker, was also in the limelight, taking two first places and ten points for his team. There were 16 events scheduled, but owing to the high wind the two hurdle races were called off.

The track was slow and the showing good, considering the conditions. The Baker team made a total of 61 points against 49 made by all their rivals together, including Wallows, 18; Pendleton 12; La Grande 9; Athena 5; Ontario 4; Union 1.

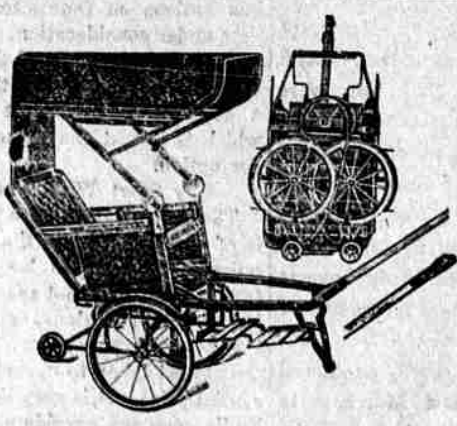
