Remembrances should be made with floral tributes in the home and no one will be seen without a flower on Mothers' Day.

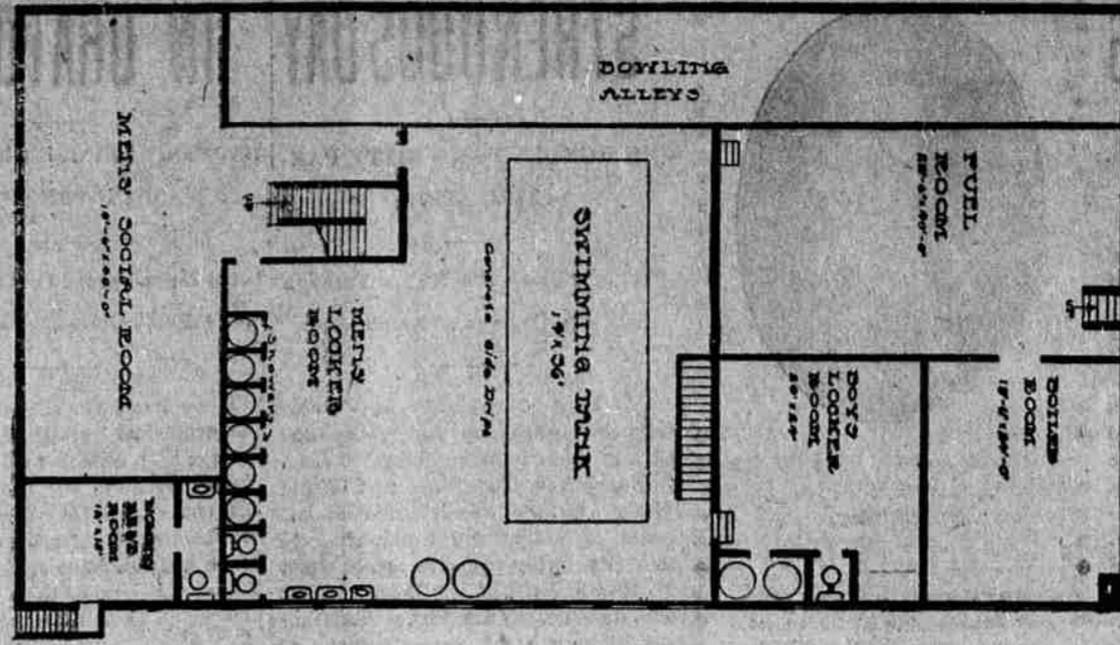
WHITE FLOWERS FOR MOTHER'S MEMORY.

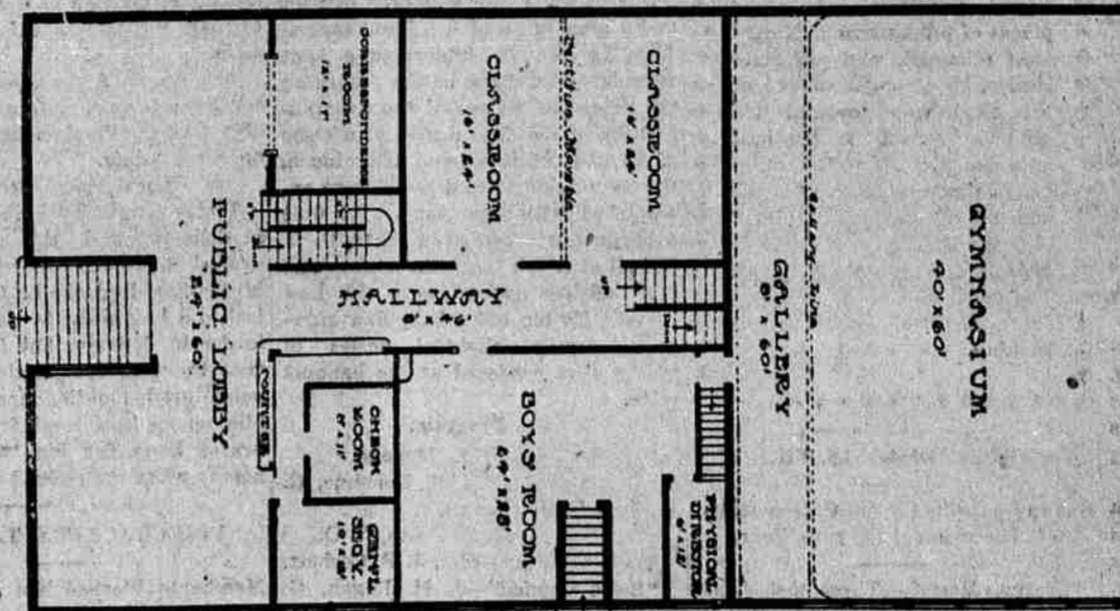

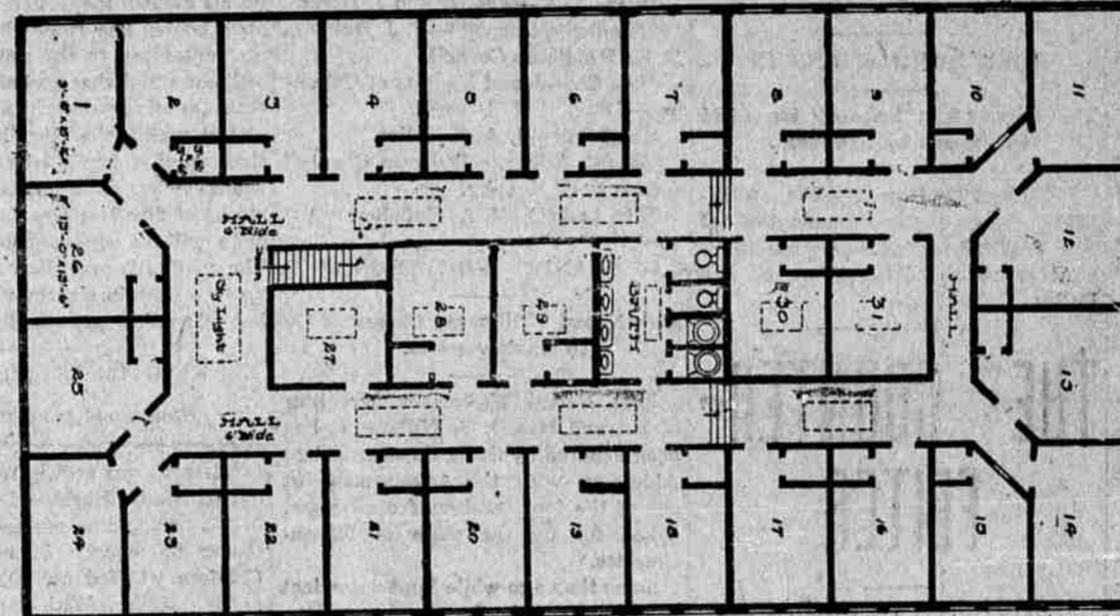
VIEWS OF PROPOSED Y. M. C. A. BUILDING IN THIS CITY
