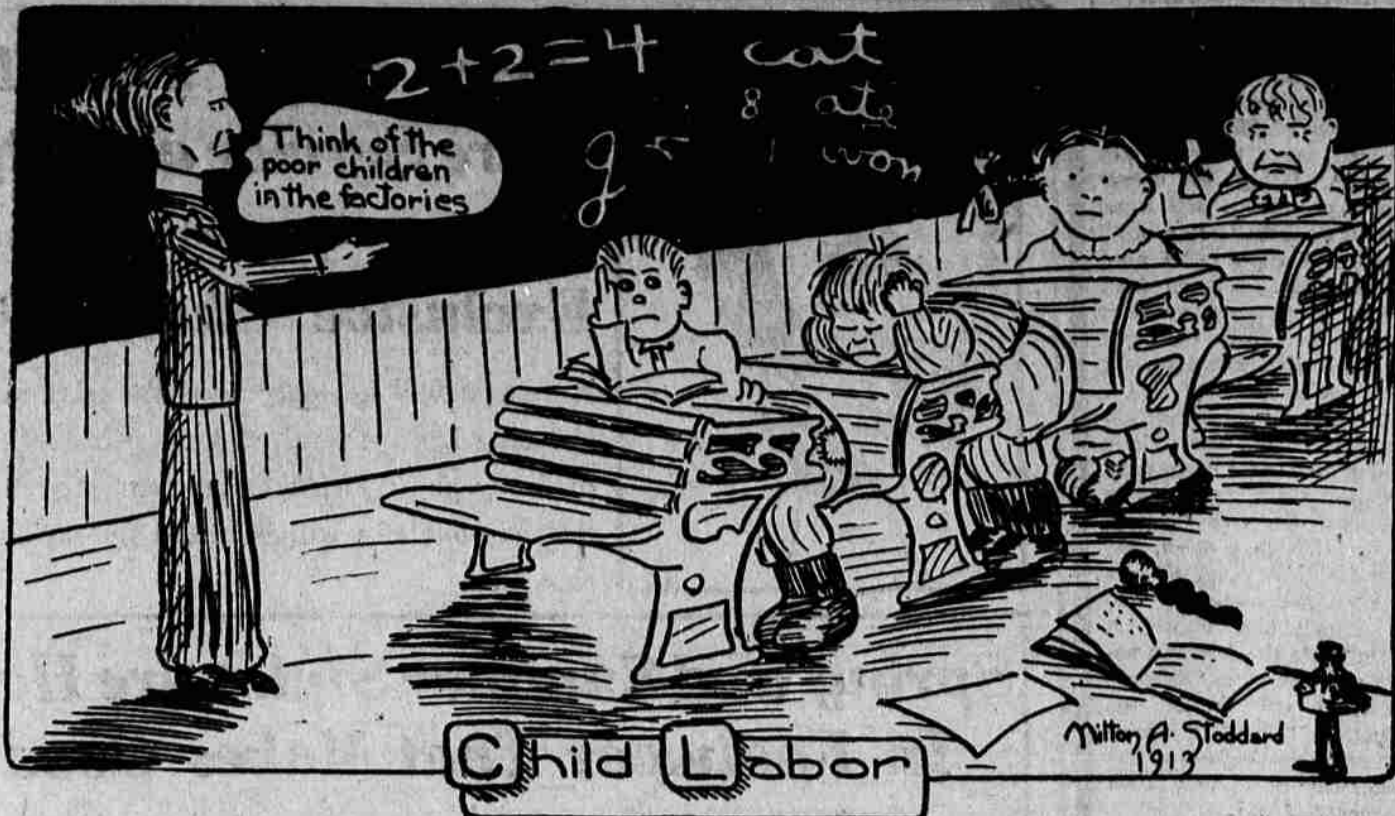


CARTOON FEATURE OF ANNUAL
