Pittsburg, May 20.—Search for the fiend who outraged and strangled to death Grace Johnson, 14, and pretty, of Trafford, near here, is prosecuted today. The girl failed to return home from school yesterday and her father started a search. He found her body in some bushes by the road side, cold in death, her torn clothing and other evidence showing before she was choked to death had been cruelly outraged. It is believed, if the perpetrator is captured, lynching, and possibly burning, is almost certain.
