Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the County Clerk of Union county, Oregon, at La Grande, Oregon, up to 12:00 o'clock M of the 4th day of June, 1913, for the furnishing of all tools, labor and material necessary for the following work:  
I. Take down the old bridge near Cove, furnish all tools, labor and material except the fabricated steel superstructure now at La Grande, for a 60 foot span on foundations, according to plans and specifications now on file.  
II. Take down the old bridge near Summerville, point up the present masonry piers, put six-inch concrete cap on walls, or, put in new concrete abutments, furnish all tools, labor and material, except the fabricated steel for the superstructure which is now at La Grande, for a new 60 foot span at the site of the old bridge.

All material to be furnished and work done in accordance with the plans and specifications on file at the office of the County Clerk in the city of La Grande, Oregon. Each bidder shall deposit with his bid a cashier's check for five per cent of the amount of his proposal, as a guarantee of good faith. All bids shall be sealed and addressed to the County Judge of Union County, Oregon, and endorsed: "Bids for the building of the Cove and Summerville Bridges."

Bidders shall submit separate proposals for each of the above bridges. The right is reserved to reject any or all bids or award the contract, as may be to the best interests of Union County.

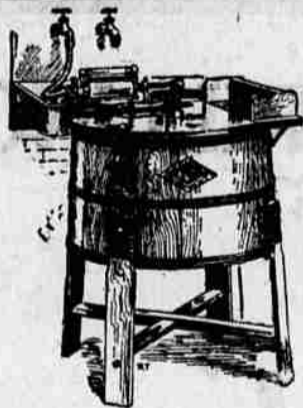
