Train Delayed.

Number 32 did not arrive in Joseph until 7 p. m. due to a great delay caused by fallen trees and much rock and earth washed on the track by the many freshets. The Wallowa river and the many creeks are rapidly rising and a very high mark is expected unless both the warm weather and heavy rains cease at once.

Conley Farm Damaged.

Red Pepper School District, May 28.—(Special)—This section of the Grande Ronde valley was hit by a dust storm Monday and a rainstorm yesterday. The wind was terribly strong. It blew one of George Conley's hay-racks and wagon over against the fence, breaking the fence down also smashing the hay rack, and breaking the coupling pole in the wagon.

Dust Storm at North Powder.

North Powder, May 28.—(Special) This place was visited yesterday afternoon by the most severe wind storm that has passed over this section for a long time. The dust was so thick that it was impossible to see across the street. The gable end of a house just across the track from the station was blown out, a fence was blown down, and the streets were littered with branches blown from the trees. The rain following the wind was not sufficient to lay the dust. A heavy shower occurred later in the evening, and it is still showering today.

Lightning and Hail at Elgin.

Elgin, May 28.—(Special)—Elgin was visited today and yesterday with very heavy rains. Water fell in torrents for a while yesterday morning and then followed up with hail. Al-

though no extensive damage was done it discomposes many people and stops lumber hauling for a few days.

The lightning struck the long distance telephone line today and did slight damage to the switch board.

The Grande Ronde river is gradually rising, due to the warm weather and the rains, which cause the rapid melting of the snow in the mountains. The river has not as yet reached its water mark that it reached in April.
