Corbett's fancy roping amused the audience during several of the dull moments. Corbett's smile and grit as well as ability is rapidly placing him among the famous buckaroos of the northwest.

In the gentleman's driving competition Will Vowet, Dr. Myers and Bob Withycombe took the honors in the order named, after which event Blanchett livened things up a little by riding a wild horse. In the combination harness and saddle contest Conley's horses took all the honors in that event.

Record in Chariot Race.

In the second part of the chariott race Zib Morirs driving John Spain's horses set a new record for the Union track in the wonderful time of 57 seconds. The race was not as exciting as yesterday but at that was one of the sensations of the day.

Champion Rides Horse.

John Spain, erstwhile champion cow boy rider of the world, gave a clever exhibition of buckaroo riding, successfully staying with a pitching animal fresh from the range. Spain, though handicapped by the loss of one arm, is still one of the best riders in the country.

Relay Reduced to 2 1/2 Miles.

Bloom, riding for Spain, beat Herford, riding for Conley, in a nip and tuck five lap race winning merely by a length. Spain forfeited the 12 1/2 mile event but consented to run his horses in the five lap race.

1/4 Mile Dash Fast.

Clark, riding Sammy Mullen, owned by Hi Peach of La Grande, won from the field in a fast and close quarter in the time of :34-1-2. Pinnegar riding Ragged Bill for Pierce, taking second, and Turk on Billie Wallace, owned by John Spain, third. The La Grande horse won that event the day before. The last and best special on the program was Frank Hogg successfully sticking to a real bucking bull. Although the beast broke through the gates out of sight of the spectators, Hogg rode him until the animal stopped his volcanic heaves.

In the 3-4 mile cowboy race, Max by Wilson, Eva McGinnis by White, and Charley by Gray, finished in the order named, the time being 1:27 1/2. In the pacing contest Wortman, Nowal, and McKennon captured the honors respectively.

The ladies' relay finished the day's program, Muad Auburn winning, due to Mrs. Pierce's dangerous accident.

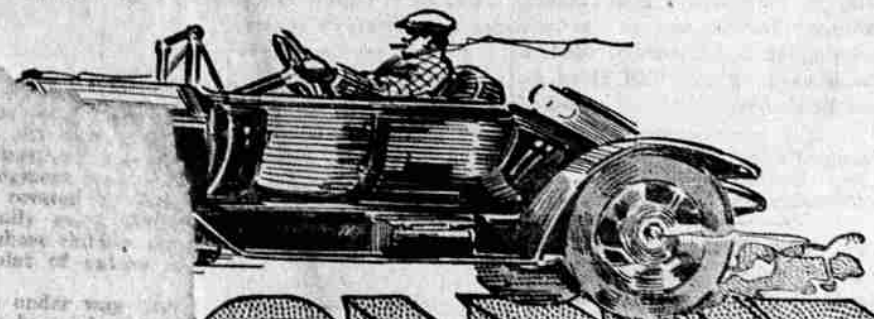
