REAL RACE

Charming Lecturer Has Repertoire of
Fancy Themes.

Walt Holcomb, the original "Holcomb of horse race fame," is to be one of the principal attractions at the coming Chautauqua. Mr. Holcomb got his idea for the horse race as the car in which he was traveling passed a race track near Nashville, Tenn. He observed, as the train rounded the bend, that the thoroughbreds were on the home stretch. The trainmen were on the platforms, the passengers leaned from the car windows and the engineer and fireman made use of the cab windows, from this little bit of human interest Mr. Holcomb conceived the idea of his lecture which brings crowds to their feet as they see the horses bunched for the race, the start, the final spurt and the finish, as plainly as those on the track at the old county fair.

After seeing and hearing the lecture, Dr. Wilbur L. Davidson, formerly president of the National Chautauqua bureau, said:

The Horse Race lecture outdraws the county fair and is a perfect gem. It is so different, and therein lies its strength. His lectures abound in illustrations and anecdote and scintillate with wit. Homely philosophy and sublime truth are happily blended."

Domestic Science Department to Have
New Color.

ADDED FEATURE LIKELY.

Late this week offers from the Oregon Agricultural society which call for the providing of a cooking expert during the assembly were accepted, and while her program of lectures and demonstrations have not been fully announced, it is likely that a "double dose" will be provided for the women this year. The outline given below will be the basis with the cooking and newly-added features in addition. This should make the domestic science and art departments, the greatest attractions of their kind in the history of the Chautauqua.

The board has arranged something unique in the line of domestic science this year. For the past three years attention has been given entirely to a system of cooking.
