Street Improvement. described, as to the valuation and extent, if any of the benefits to be derived by said property by reason of said improvement, have made their report in writing to said council, which report has been received by said council, and is on file in the office of the recorder of said city, and is open for your inspection. That it is the intention of said council to levy a special assessment against all the

property hereinafter described for the purpose of paying the costs and expenses of improving North Second street between the north line of "W" Avenue and the center of Lake Avenue by laying thereon macadam pavement on the roadway of said street, a width of forty feet, and constructing cement curbs, according to the plans and specifications therefore heretofore adopted by said council and on file in the office of the Recorder of said city.

That the real property included in and the boundaries of the district benefitted and affected by said proposed improvement are as follows:

North Second street and the West half of blocks 3, 4, 7, 8, 11, 15, and 16 and the east half of Blocks 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, and 23, in Riverside Addition to the City of La Grande, Oregon, and the west half of Block 4 and the east half of Block 9 in Ryneerson's Addition to the City of La Grande, Oregon, all in the City of La Grande, Oregon, and the estimated cost of said proposed improvement is \$14,214.30. You will further take notice that said city council will meet at the council chamber in the city building of said city on the 18th day of June, 1913, at 8 o'clock p. m. of said day to consider making the proposed levy and will then and there grant a hearing to any and all persons feeling aggrieved against, or on account of, said proposed assessment.
