**FINE PRICES FOR CATTLE**

**WALLOWA RANGES SEND STOCK TO MARKET.**

Six Cents Paid for "Fresh From the Range" Meatstuff.

Enterprise, June 28.—(Special)—Hog and cattle raisers of Wallowa county are reaping a rich harvest.

The spring round-up in the Chesh-nimnus is over and cattlemen report the best crop of calves known in years. Calves are both numerous and strong. They were branded and the stock turned in the range again.

Warren Chandler came in Sunday from La Grande and saw some of the cattle owners, but did not get to see the stock. However, he bought everything offered "unsight and unseen" at the ranchmen's price—6 cents a pound. He only got about two cars at that. This price is a record breaker for range cattle. It means \$60 for a cow weighing 1000 pounds right from the grass and in the spring.

The north end of the county descended on Enterprise with the largest string of hogs ever shipped out at one time. There were nearly fifty teams and about 35 men and boys as drivers. They brought out 400 hogs, making four carloads. The hogs averaged a shade over 200 pounds each and were nearly a year old.
