**EGGS RAISED TO 25 CENTS**

**UNEXPECTED RAISE IN LOCAL MARKET COMES.**

Cucumbers Decline Slightly While Eggs Show Incline Up

Eggs picked up a point today, raising from 20c to 25c. It is rather unexpected merchants admit but there has been a bullish attitude in the egg market in the larger centers for some time, and the effect has become local in nature today.

Other than this the Monday morning markets presented no material change, Cucumbers are down to 15 cents and two for 25 cents, but the other varieties of vegetables and seasonable stuff remains the same.
