

ASIDE BY O-W

LA GRANDE TO HAVE SHOPS IMPROVED THIS YEAR.

President Farrel Outlines Expenditure for Coming Twelve Months.

La Grande is to get an appreciable portion of the O-W appropriations for the ensuing year according to President Farrel, in Portland papers yesterday, when some notion of the big expenditures of the coming year are outlined. Touching on these appropriations, the article in a Portland paper said:

The forthcoming budget of the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation company will make provision for additions, general betterment, maintenance and equipment and completion this year of the projects already under way.

"I cannot give you an approximation of the total amount to be appropriated," said President Farrel today. "The amount is a very flexible one and not susceptible to approximation."

The Oregon Eastern line will be completed to Riverside, 80 miles west of Vale, as will the new air line from the Snake river to Spokane. Surveying for the Fossil and Pilot Rock extensions will be continued, also the survey of the line from Centralia to Willapa harbor. A large appropriation will also be made to improve the shops at Albina, La Grande and intermediate shops.

The passenger and freight terminals at Spokane will also be completed. At Tacoma there will be constructed a freight house, team tracks, yards and a bridge over the city waterway. In the way of new equipment President Farrel said that 1000 box cars were on the way. During the past year 150 miles of track has been relayed with 90 pound steel rails at various places in Oregon and Washington.
