Home grown raspberries made their appearance today. Cove sent over a shipment of excellent quality and scattering crates of La Grande grown berries likewise went on sale. The price remains unchanged.

Peaches are selling at 20 cents per dozen, rather than by the pound weight but the change in measure doesn't materially effect the price. The Milton variety is growing better right along and choice peaches will soon be a regular commodity of trade.
