La Grande lost 9-4 at Enterprise, and Elgin lost 8-1 at Wallowa. Smith allowed 10 hits and Culver four.

At Enterprise Ray Oliver had an off day and the Enterprise crowd lamed in nine runs in two innings or so. "Naughty" Naughton, ex-Spud infielder, immediately earned for himself new renown when he went to the hill and for the first time in his career pitched seven innings. "Naughty" has nothing on earth in the pitching line except a windup and this was so astonishingly big-league like that he completely jinxed the Enterprisers and narry a runner crossed the pan after "Naughty" got his windup going.
