## CHERRY RUSH OPENS TUESDAY

FIRST CARLOAD GOING OUT TOMORROW SOMETIME.

Hum of Activity in Cherry Fields Gets Under Way.

### SUGAR GOES HIGHER.

Another 10-cent raise on sugar, the third within a month's time has been tacked on the price of a hundred pound sack. It is presumed that Eastern sugar dealers are bulling the price in anticipation of cheaper sugar later on when the tariff becomes effective.

Hum of strenuous action in picking and marketing Grande Ronde cherries started today and tomorrow will be keyed to its highest pitch. The first carload will be loaded out of the valley in this city, tomorrow barring rain this evening and from then on it will pick, haul and load as fast as human hands and power conveyances can accomplish the act. The cherry rush is on, or will be on in full blast tomorrow and the rest of this month will find the season's crop, a record in size, harvested with returns of about \$25,000 to the comparatively few cherry growers, for extensive cherry raising is not in the hands of many like wheat raising, but conducted by a few and for that reason the distribution of \$25,000 means much to those interested.
