UMATILLA WHEAT SOLD

FIRST CONSIGNMENT GOES TO PORTLAND.

Farmers in General Hurry Cutting In Umatilla Wheat Belt.

Pendleton, July 23.—The first sale of new wheat was reported yesterday. Dave Nelson, well known farmer, sold a considerable quantity of Turkey Red to Balfour-Guthrie and it is being loaded out today. The wheat was of an extra good quality, testing 64, and brought a price a little above the market. The actual price is not given out.

With the hot weather continuing the grain is ripening fast and the farmers are not delaying the commencement of operations any longer than is absolutely necessary. They fear a hard rain, which would loosen the chaff and make shattering easy in any wind. Among the farmers who have commenced cutting this week are Ernest Knight, Spencer Bentley, Ed Lydie Tom Thompson and Wyrick and Sturgis.

TEMPERANCE MEET IS SET

COUNTY ORGANIZATION WILL TAKE PLACE HERE.

Signers of New Pledge Will Organize County Association.

The temperance forces of the county will hold a mass meeting in the First Baptist church of La Grande on Friday evening, July 25th, at 8 o'clock, at which time it is the intention to complete an organization for the work in this county for 1913 and 1914.

This is one of the first meetings in the "Oregon dry campaign", and it is expected that it will be largely attended by those interested in the temperance cause. There is a movement on foot to combine all the temperance societies and to induce all men and women favorable to reforms along this line, to vote a straight temperance ticket, and as a part of this movement the Prohibition party has put men in the field to organize the work and get the voters enrolled under the following pledge:

"Out to Win" Voters' League.

I hereby declare my intention to vote the prohibition party ticket, whenever a sufficient number of voters have signed this enrollment to carry the state, or any political division thereof of which I am a citizen. It is also agreed that I shall have the privilege of participating in the convention or primary for the nomination of candidates. In no case am I bound to vote for unworthy candidates.

Up to this time there has been enrolled something like 10,000 men and women of this state, to vote for state-wide prohibition. "This is just a starter and the work will be carried on with great energy until election time," said a prohibitionist this morning.

Mr. A. J. Bolster, field superintendent for the district, will be the principal speaker, with H. C. Cockrum pastor of the First Presbyterian church of Union, and others.

The Methodist quartet is on the program and the combined Methodist and Baptist choirs are to furnish the music.

Husband Missing Nine Years.

New York, July 23.—Nine years ago today the mysterious mists of the metropolis enshrouded Godfrey Louis Michon, M. D., Bellevue university class of '87.

Never since that day has his wife (or widow), Mary Fallon Michon, seen him or heard directly of him. She has had clues at time—but not in recent years—but all of them proved false.

With two daughters to support Mrs. Michon went naturally into nursing, for it was while she was in training at North Brothers' island where Doctor Michon was head doctor, that she met and married the man who drifted so mysteriously to the Port of Missing Men. With a natural love for babies, Mrs. Michon turned to that branch of work, and as near as she can calculate today, she has ushered in and started properly on the road of life just two hundred and forty-three babies since that day nine years ago, when her physician-husband faded away.

"I have long ago given up hope of ever finding him," she said today. "But I would give my right hand to clear up the mystery of his disappearance. I pay the insurance on his life out of my earnings every month—it now comes to \$156 per year, and you can realize that it comes hard. I may never get anything for it, as the officials of the Catholic Benevolent legion inform me that death must be positively proved before I can realize on the policy. In all, I have paid nearly two thousand dollars on the five thousand dollar policy and I shall continue as long as I can raise my hand and as long as this terrible mystery remains unsolved. Nine years is a long, long time. I guess it's only because of the dear little babies—I love them all—and because they keep me busy, that I can stand it. My goodness, there's the telephone now—"
