IDAHO DEALER SELLS PRUNE CROP.

Forty Thousand Dollars Changed Hands on One Prune Crop.

Weiser, Idaho, July 28.—(Special)—One of the most sensational sales of Idaho fruit ever recorded is reported by Miles Cannon of this city. The sale, negotiated by Cannon's sales agents, the Northwestern Fruit Exchange of Portland, is of the entire 1913 crop of his prune orchard, and involves a cash consideration of approximately \$40,000.00.
