## RUSH ORDERS MEET DELAY

### BREAKDOWN AT PERRY MILL IN- OPPORTUNE.

Perry Swimming Season Comes to an End for 1913.

Perry, Ore., Aug. 1.—Monday the cylinderhead of the planing mill engine was blown out which shut down the planing mill and box factory and it will be several days before operations can be resumed. The broken part was sent to Baker where it will be repaired. This breakdown occurred at a very inopportune time, as the company is loaded up with rush orders and a week's layoff will put them behind considerably in their shipping. The sawmill is running full blast and the yard is well stocked with lumber.

### FIVE CENTS ADDED TO TWO- POUND ROLL.

Best Grade of Peaches Not Up to the Standard—Green Peppers Coming.

Butter went up today—five cents on the two-pound roll. This refers to ranch and creamery butter. The latter grade of butter is very scarce and the creamery butter market has been very strong of late. The rise was not unexpected.

#### Good Peaches Scarce.

While there have been plenty Milton clingstone peaches, the top variety of peaches have been scarce and there will probably be no material relief until the freestones come either from Milton or other noted peach districts. Local dealers are unable to procure a peach that is as juicy, large and luscious as peaches should be at this time of the year.
