## IMBLER SCHOOL SYSTEMS BUSY

OLD AND NEW DISTRICTS PROCEED NICELY.

Under Serious Handicaps, Schools Are Held In Church Homes.

Imbler's schools—distinctly plural—are progressing as satisfactorily as the conditions would allow, finds Mrs. A. E. Ivanhoe, county school superintendent. The old district designated as No. 11, which includes the city proper, is using the L. D. S. and the Methodist churches and one room in a private residence, while district No. 78, the new district is using the former Imbler school house and both institutions are doing exceptionally good work finds Mrs. Ivanhoe. The system is the result of the division of the district as the farming element in the original district asked for some time ago. The school house was sold to the new district leaving the old district without a place to conduct its schools as bonds with which to build are tied up in court.
