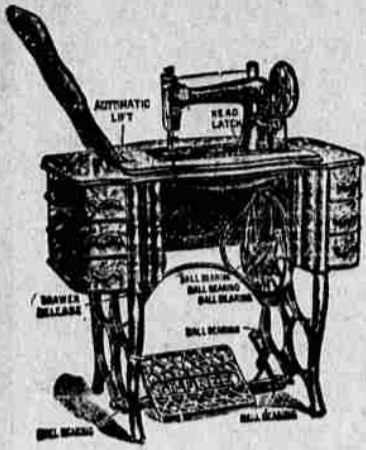

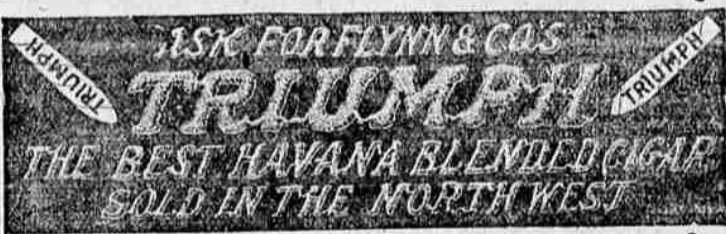

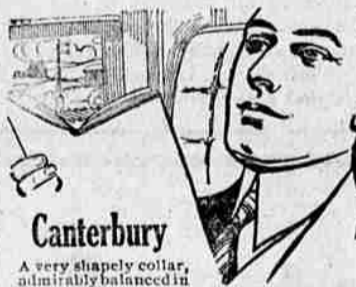

WEST CLEANUP EFFORT FAILS

PENDLETON GIRLS ACQUITTED OF STATE CHARGE.

West Agent Cannot Convict Women Charged With Running Bawdy Houses.

Pendleton, Oct. 2.—The Live Wire says: In the case of the State of Oregon, against Miss Audrey Wilson, who was charged by Thomas Kay and Detectives C. D. Dill and H. A. Foster with running the Umatilla hotel as a bawdy house, the jury returned a verdict of not guilty last evening.

The jury, through the evidence, ascertained a number of things about this case which the public had not learned. It developed that while Miss Wilson and her partner, "Teddy" Brooks, who had opened this hotel, had formerly been classed among the scarlet women, and had even been inmates of the old Oriental when it was running in its palmy days, yet when that was closed up June 29, 1913, and they had secured a lease on the building and re-opened it as the Umatilla hotel in August, their conduct would go far to convince any fair-minded persons that they had decided to try, at least, to reform.

The three officers, Chief John Kearney, Patrolman Alex Manning and Police Judge FitzGerald, were placed on the stand by the prosecution, but while all testified as to the reputation of the women during their occupancy of the Oriental, each stated that since the opening of the Umatilla hotel no complaints had been heard from any sources. Judge FitzGerald identified both Miss Wilson and Teddy Brooks as having appeared before his court charged with vagrancy in the olden days, but he said he had not heard any one complain about their conduct recently. Isaac Jay, who conducts a blacksmith shop immediately across the street from the building, confirmed as far as his observation went, the same story. The old Oriental was known and heralded abroad as a house of ill-fame but he had never heard any complaints against the Umatilla hotel.

Scrubbing, Sweeping, Dusting.

H. A. Foster, the detective sent here by Tom Kay to conduct this moral crusade, testified that he has been employed as a detective for the last three years and was sent here at the instance of Tom Kay, and for the first week after he came to the city he did not let any one, Sheriff Taylor, nor his deputies, Prosecuting Attorney Fred Steiwer, Chief of Police Jno. Kearney, nor any of his deputies know that he was in the city or what his business was, because, he alleged, oftentimes he had found local officers in sympathy with law-breakers and thought he might find the same conditions here. For a time he had a room at the Umatilla hotel, and he said that during the time he was staying there he never saw anything suspicious in the conduct of Miss Wilson. She was always working, neatly attired, he never saw her drinking, she was not familiar with any of the guests, nor smoking cigarettes. He had, however, seen her down on her knees scrubbing the floors, saw her sweeping and dusting, making up the beds, cleaning up the rooms and running a sewing machine making some garments, and otherwise doing just what one would expect from a woman trying to earn an honest living by conducting a rooming and lodging house. Yet in the face of this condition of affairs, he swore out a complaint against her as a keeper of a bawdy house and ruined her business as lodging house keeper.

Admits He Assaulted Girl.

He further admits that during the time he was lodging there he deliberately committed an assault upon Teddy Brooks, Miss Wilson's partner. While sitting in his room he looked down the hallway and saw Miss Brooks come out of her room clad in a large gingham apron only and cross the hall to the small store-room and he, the detective, ran up behind her and pulled apart the apron and remarked to his partner, Dill, that she "had a fine form." Miss Brooks jerked away from him and ran into the store-room and he did not see her face. He also admitted that the afternoon was one of the hot, sultry August days

when any clothes seemed like a burden to one. His partner, Mr. Dill, corroborated Mr. Foster's evidence all the way through. The defense used four witnesses. Miss Wilson, the defendant, told how she and Miss Brooks had obtained a lease on the building after the closing of the Oriental and about the money spent in re-furnishing and fitting it up. Her attitude and manner of telling her story, together with the corroborative testimony that had already been given by the prosecution, convinced the jury that she was telling the truth.
